	FABRICS:				
	3⁄4 yards fabric for Setting Triangles. I recommend you start with a striped or multi-color fabric for the Setting Triangles and choose fabrics to coordinate with it to create the rest of this quilt. The stripe is not required but I would love to show you how fun they are to use.				
	½ of a yard of different fabrics for your 9-patch units, setting squares and border corners.				
	1 Yard of the fabric for the border and binding – we will not be using this fabric in class but we will discuss borders and binding techniques.				
	We will not get to the backing and batting but when you are ready for that you will need 3 yards for the backing (I would suggest a fabric with a small busy multi-color print) and a batting that is 48" square.				
	Rotary cutter, 45mm size				
	Rotary mat: Mat 18" x 24" recommended				
	Ruler – a square that is at least 9½" – if you have one larger that is fine.				
	Ruler – 6"x24", or 6½" or 8½" wide				
	100% Cotton 50 Weight piecing thread – neutral color				
	Straight pins – I recommend a fine pin such as the Clover Silk glass ball head pins.				
	Seam Guilds from Guildlines4Quilters.				
	Spray Sizing – Mary Ellen's Best Press or the new Magic brand				
	Good quality seam ripper
